

- Must contain interesting/useful information about basketball


Second Major Stakeholder Consultation

Key Factors and their Interactions







Prioritisation of Key Factors


High Priority Key Factors




Medium Priority Key Factors

After Stakeholder Consultation

The team wanted the following in the solution

- Having a team of 5 characters This has changed to 2 main characters.

After Modeling

- While trying to figure out how to get the scoreboard and animations working at the same time in modeling I realised I could only do one of the options. I have chosen to use just the scoreboard as it is better than the animations because it keeps your score during the quiz.
- Creating characters in fireworks was quite time consuming. I talked to some stakeholders and we decided to just use 2 main characters.
