Tech Practice - The process you go through when developing outcomes

1, Brief Development

- Can be given a CONTEXT eg Skirt or a Class Brief
- Needs / Opps - Prioritise, Justify
- Key Factors - Prioritise, Justify
- BRIEF - in two parts Conceptual Statement & Specifications

2, Planning

- How you planned time allocation - Gantt Chart
- How you recorded planning throughout your work
- How planning is 'looking forward' & 'reflecting' on work done.

3, Developing the Solution

- How you recorded this throughout your work
- Notes that explain decisions considered and made
- Drawings, sketches, & photocopied material from references
- Photos taken at key stages

4, Evaluations

- How you recorded this throughout your work
- Final evaluation at the end of the unit
